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3. Hazard Identification (CLP Classification)

(Based on typical SDS classification)

- Eye Irritation – Category 2

Hazard Statements

- H319: Causes serious eye irritation

Precautionary Statements

- P264: Wash hands thoroughly after handling
- P280: Wear eye protection if splashing risk

- P305+P351+P338: IF IN EYES: Rinse cautiously with water
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4. Composition / Hazardous Ingredients

- Contains surfactants and cleaning agents
 - No substances classified as hazardous above threshold levels
 - No Workplace Exposure Limits identified
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5. Routes of Exposure

- Eye contact (primary risk)
 - Skin contact (low risk)
 - Inhalation (minimal, non-aerosol)
 - Ingestion (accidental)
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6. Persons at Risk

- Cleaning operatives
 - Other staff in vicinity
 - Public/clients (very low risk)
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7. Exposure Assessment

Factor	Detail
Frequency	Daily
Duration	Short-term (minutes per task)
Quantity	Small amounts (trigger spray)
Environment	Domestic & commercial indoor areas

8. Control Measures (Hierarchy Applied)

Elimination/Substitution

- Not required (low hazard product)

Engineering Controls

- General ventilation sufficient

Administrative Controls

- Follow manufacturer instructions
- Avoid spraying towards face
- Do not mix with other cleaning products

PPE

- Gloves (recommended for prolonged/repeated use)
 - Eye protection (only if splash risk present)
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9. Workplace Exposure Limits (WELs)

- No Workplace Exposure Limits assigned (confirmed via SDS)
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10. First Aid Measures

- **Eyes:** Rinse with clean water for at least 10–15 minutes. Seek advice if irritation persists
 - **Skin:** Wash with soap and water
 - **Inhalation:** Not normally required — move to fresh air if irritation occurs
 - **Ingestion:** Rinse mouth. Seek medical advice if unwell
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11. Fire Safety

- Not classified as flammable
- Standard fire procedures apply

12. Spill / Emergency Procedures

- Wipe up with cloth or absorbent material
 - Rinse area with water
 - Avoid slip hazard
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13. Storage

- Store in original labelled container
 - Keep sealed when not in use
 - Store away from food
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14. Environmental Considerations

- Avoid unnecessary release to drains
 - Low environmental impact under normal use
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15. Monitoring & Supervision

- Supervisor checks:
 - Safe use
 - Correct storage
 - Periodic spot checks
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16. Training Requirements

- COSHH awareness training
 - Induction training for new staff
 - Basic chemical handling instruction
